How AFS and the Forest Practices System Interact

AFS and the Forest Practices System are entirely complementary.

The Forest Practices System provides the local and regional operational Standards upon which form the basis of Sustainable Forest Management.

The fundamental principal of AS4708 is that all forests are different and management is tailored at a local and regional level.

Under the AFS, forest management must comply with all legal requirements including the Forest Practices System

an emphasis on self-regulation	A voluntary Standard implemented by Forest Managers
planning before forest operations	Criteria 1.2- Forest Management Plan
delegated and decentralised approvals for forest practices plans and other forest practices matters	Criteria 1.3.2(a)- Evidence of the Legal Right to Harvest
an emphasis on consultation and education	Criteria 2- Stakeholders
an emphasis on research, review and continuing improvement	Criteria 1.6- Research Criteria 1.1(b)- Continual Improvement

the conservation of threatened native vegetation communities	Criteria 3- Biodiversity

an independent appeal process	Criteria 2.2(g)- Complaints and dispute resolution
