Non-admitted patient telehealth service event - definition

- Non-admitted patient service events (1:1 consultations or group sessions) delivered via videoconferencing technology.
- *An interaction between one or more healthcare provider(s) with one non-admitted patient, which must contain therapeutic/clinical content and result in a dated entry in the patient's medical record.” Australian Institute of Health and Welfare*


Non-admitted patient telehealth service event – data capture & reporting

- Activity data captured via patient administration systems include:
 - HBCIS APP (appointment scheduling);
 - OSIM;
 - ASIM; and
 - MS Excel.
 - Activity data reported via the Monthly Activity Collection (MAC).
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Non-admitted patient telehealth service event - funding (public)

- Queensland Activity Based Funding Model
 - Pays both the provider and recipient end
 - Independent Hospital Pricing Authority Tier 2 Clinic types.
 - From 1 February 2014 public telehealth non-admitted patient service events uncapped.
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Non-admitted patient telehealth service event - funding (private)

- MBS telehealth items.
 - 11 specialist end items.
 - 23 patient-end items.
 - MBS billing requirements must be met.
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Admitted patient telehealth event - definition

- Interactive real-time clinical activity provided for an admitted patient within a Telehealth session.
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Admitted patient telehealth event – data capture and reporting

- Activity captured via the HBCIS Telehealth Inpatient Details screen.
- Activity reported via the Queensland Hospital Admitted Patient Data Collection.
